VETERANS INFORMATION

VFW Joins Domestic Military Toxic Exposures Roundtable: House Committee on Veterans' Affairs Ranking Member Mark Takano (CA-39) convened a roundtable with more than a dozen veteran organizations and advocacy groups to discuss toxic exposures on and around domestic military bases. VFW National Legislative Associate Director Nancy Springer shared insights on military firefighter exposure to per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which stem from the use of aqueous film forming foam to extinguish fuel fires. She also stressed the need for Congress to carefully monitor the VA Presumption Decision Process that systematically evaluates presumptive conditions of service connection.

VFW Testimony for House Subcommittee Hearing: VFW National Legislative Associate Director Nancy Springer provided a statement for the record for a House Veterans' Affairs Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs hearing on VA's efforts to decrease delays in processing claims. Springer explained that not fully evaluating a claimant's record and requiring unnecessary examinations or medical reviews causes delays. VA highlighted how its improved automated tools and enhanced training programs are accelerating the

House Passes Six Veteran Bills: The House passed six bipartisan bills for veterans and their families. The VFW recently testified in support of <u>H.R. 1039</u>, *Clear Communication for Veterans Claims Act*, that would simplify VA notice letters to make them more understandable to recipients; and <u>H.R. 1228</u>, *Prioritizing Veterans' Survivors Act*, that would move the Office of Survivors Assistance to the Office of the Sec-

As part of its VetServe 2025 campaign, VA's National Day of Service on April 23 will focus on strengthening the capacity of volunteers and highlighting their positive impact. BATTLE OF THE MONTH



Battle of the Wilderness

The **Battle of the Wilderness** was fought on May 5–7, 1864, during the <u>American Civil War</u>. It was the first battle of <u>Lieutenant General Ulysses S. Grant</u>'s 1864 Virginia <u>Overland Campaign</u> against <u>General Robert E. Lee</u> and the <u>Confederate Army of Northern Virginia</u>. The fighting occurred in a wooded area near <u>Locust Grove, Virginia</u>, about 20 miles (32 km) west of <u>Fredericksburg</u>. Both armies suffered heavy casualties, nearly 29,000 in total, a harbinger of a <u>war of attrition</u> by Grant against Lee's army and, eventually, against the Confederate capital, <u>Richmond, Virginia</u>. The battle was <u>tactically</u> inconclusive, as Grant disengaged and then continued his offensive.


Grant attempted to move quickly through the dense underbrush of the <u>Wilderness of Spotsylvania</u>, but Lee launched two of his <u>corps</u> on parallel roads to intercept him. On the morning of May 5, the <u>Union V Corps</u> under <u>Major General Gouverneur K. Warren</u> attacked the Confederate <u>Second Corps</u>, commanded by <u>Lieutenant General Richard S. Ewell</u>, on the Orange Turnpike. That afternoon the <u>Third Corps</u>, commanded by <u>Lieutenant General A. P. Hill</u>, encountered <u>Brigadier General George W. Getty</u>'s <u>division</u> (<u>VI Corps</u>) and Major General <u>Winfield S. Hancock</u>'s Union <u>II Corps</u> on the Orange Plank Road. Fighting, which ended for the evening because of darkness, was fierce but inconclusive as both sides attempted to maneuver in the dense woods.

At dawn on May 6, Hancock attacked along the Plank Road, driving Hill's corps back in confusion, but the <u>First Corps</u> of Lieutenant General <u>James Longstreet</u> arrived in time to prevent the collapse of the Confederate right flank. Longstreet followed up with a surprise flanking attack from an unfinished railroad bed that drove Hancock's men back, but the momentum was lost when Longstreet was <u>wounded by his own men</u>. An evening attack by <u>Brigadier General John B. Gordon</u> against the Union right flank caused consternation at the Union headquarters, but the lines stabilized and fighting ceased. On May 7, Grant disengaged and moved to the southeast, intending to leave the Wilderness to interpose his army between Lee and Richmond, leading to the <u>Battle of Todd's Tavern</u> and <u>Battle of Spotsylvania Court House</u>.




